Chairman, Nevada Gaming Control Board

Mr. A.G. Burnett has served on the Nevada Gaming Control Board since 2011 and was appointed Chairman of the agency by the Governor of Nevada in October 2012. Mr. Burnett also serves as a Trustee and the Treasurer for the International Association of Gaming Regulators. He is an expert on legal matters in the gambling industry and has experience working with foreign regulatory agencies.

During his tenure at the Nevada Gaming Control Board, Mr. Burnett has travelled extensively to Asia and is credited for strengthening relationships with regulatory counterparts in Macau and Singapore. He recently travelled with the Nevada Gaming Control Board to Macau on a mission to strengthen relations with Macau's Gaming Inspection and Coordination Bureau (DICJ). During the trip, he also travelled to Hong Kong to meet with law enforcement officials to discuss gaming regulation in the region.

Mr. Burnett received his J.D. from Gonzaga University School of Law in 1996, and his B.A. in International Affairs and Political Science from the University of Nevada, Reno in 1992. He served on the Executive Committee of the State Bar of Nevada's Gaming Law Section from 2000-2006, and also served on the Bar's Functional Equivalency Committee from 2001-2005. He is a member of the Nevada State Bar, and is licensed to practice before all Nevada and Federal courts.
