| DS362 | Measures Affecting the Protection and Enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights | April 10, 2007 | January 26, 2009; adopted March 20, 2009 | N/A | The Panel upheld some but not all U.S. claims. China announced it has fully complied with the WTO ruling in March 2010. |
| DS363 | Measures Affecting Trading Rights and Distribution Services for Certain Publications and Audiovisual Entertainment Products | April 10, 2007 | August 12, 2009 | December 21, 2009 | The Panel upheld some but not all U.S. claims; the Appellate Body upheld the Panel findings. China agreed to implement the WTO ruling by March, 19 2011. As of May 2012, China said that it had taken all necessary steps and had thus complied with the Panel recommendations, but the United States said that the final resolution has not been reached. |
| DS373 | Measures Affecting Financial Information Services and Foreign Financial Information Suppliers | March 3, 2008 | Mutually agreed solution December 4, 2008 | | China issued new regulations for foreign financial news services and named a new, purportedly independent, regulator. |
| DS387 | Grants, Loans, and Other Incentives (Famous Brands) | December 19, 2008 | Mutually agreed solution December 18, 2009 | | China confirmed that it has taken steps to eliminate all of the |

| DS394 | Measures Related to the Exportation of Various Raw Materials | June 23, 2009 | July 5, 2011 | January 30, 2012 | The Panel upheld U.S. claims; but some were overturned by the Appellate Body. The United States and China agreed that China should implement the Panel recommendations and rulings by December 31, 2012. |
| DS413 | Measures Affecting U.S. Suppliers of Electronic Payment Services | September 15, 2010 | July 16, 2012 | N/A | The Panel upheld U.S. claims. China agreed to implement the Panel's recommendations by July 31, 2013. China notified implementation, but the United States found China has not yet taken steps to authorize access by foreign suppliers to this market; the USTR is considering next steps at the WTO. |
| DS414 | Measures Imposing Countervailing and Antidumping Duties on Grain Oriented Flat-Rolled Electrical Steel (GOES) | September 15, 2010 | June 15, 2012 | October 18, 2012 | The Panel upheld U.S. claims, and the Appellate Body upheld the Panel decision; China agreed to implement the ruling by July 31, 2013. In January 2014, the United States requested consultations with China regarding China's failure to implement WTO ruling. |
| DS419 | Measures concerning wind power equipment | December 22, 2010 | In consultations; panel not yet formed | | The United States requested consultations with China regarding provision of grants, funds, or awards to enterprises manufacturing wind power equipment in China. |

| DS427 | Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duty Measures on Broiler Products from the United States | September 20, 2011 | August 2, 2013 | | The Panel upheld most U.S. claims. In July 2014, July 2014, China informed the WTO that it had fully implemented the Panel's decision. The United States disagreed with China's assertion that it had fully complied. |
| DS431 | Measures Related to the Exportation of Rare Earths, Tungsten and Molybdenum | March 13, 2012 | March 26, 2014 | August 8, 2014 | The Panel upheld U.S. claims. In April 2014, both parties to the dispute appealed certain issues of law covered in the panel report. The Appellate Body rejected China's appeal, and did not rule on the U.S. appeal. |
| DS440 | Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties on Certain Automobiles from the United States | July 5, 2012 | May 23, 2014 | | The Panel agreed with the United States that China's imposition of antidumping and countervailing duties on U.S.-made cars and SUVs violated China's obligations under the WTO. |
| DS450 | Certain Measures Affecting the Automobile and Automobile-Parts Industries | September 17, 2012 | In consultations | | The United States requested consultations with China concerning export-contingent provisions of certain subsidies and other incentives to automobile and automobile-parts enterprises in China. |
| DS489 | Measures Related to Demonstration Bases and Common Service Programmes | February 11, 2015 | In consultations; panel formed | | The United States requested consultations with China regarding certain measures providing subsidies contingent upon export performance to enterprises in several industries in China. |
| DS501 | Tax Measures Concerning Certain Domestically Produced Aircraft | December 8, 2015 | In consultations | | The United States requested consultation with China regarding its measures exempting certain |
